Memo field	<p>1. The students need to fulfill the following requirements: They need to get 128 credits from their courses which include 1. General courses (26 credits): which include practical English, Chinese reading and composition I, II, Physical Education, club, Service Education, Program Design and Workplace English, Civics and Social Studies, 2. Self-chosen Courses (6 credits) which include two of the following three fields (Art and Literature, Social Science Studies, and Natural Science), 3. Yuan-regulated Courses (10 credits) and (14 credit) for Cross-Field studies and must-chosen of Professional Fields (48 credits) and (24 credits) of free-chosen professional courses. (the department admits 12 credits that students get from the courses of other departments)</p> <p>2. National defense education courses I, II, III, IV, V (not a must-chosen course for freshmen and sophomore (0 credits) (altogether 8 hours.) physical education I, II (must-chosen course) (altogether 4 credits and 4 hours) Club I, II (altogether 2 hours and 2 hours) service education (1 credit 2 hours) Practical English (classified into A, B, C groups)</p> <p>3. Cross-field 14 credits</p> <p>4. 6 credits and 8 hours for topic research</p> <p>5. Work as Intern in Japan: 320 hours for intern in Japan, 4 credits</p> <p>6. For the first-, second- and the third-year students, for every semester, they need to get at least 16 credits or at most 25 credits, and for the fourth-year students, they need to get at least 9 credits or at most 25 credits.</p> <p>7. To graduate, the students can also take other measures as follows: (1)The students pass the Chinese proficiency test of our school. (2)The students get the Grade I English Proficiency Test (3)The students get the certificates as admitted by our school. (4)The students get the Grade N2 Certificate of Japanese Proficiency Test from International Japanese Foundation or they need to take Japanese courses (listening, speaking, writing and reading) (altogether 4 credits) and fulfill its requirements. If they get a tour guide certificate, they don't need to take them.</p>
